JOSEPH RAMPOLLA Class of 1978

Graduating from Southern Class of 1978, Joe Rampolla had 7 Varsity Letters in his repertoire. Joe was on the Varsity Gymnastic Team all 3 years at Southern, competing in Floor Exercise, Horizontal Bar, Vaulting and Parallel Bars under the guidance of Coach Mittman. In his Senior year he was the Captain of the team, which finished the 1978 season with an impressive record of 7 wins and only 2 losses. At the Individual Championship Meet, Joe took 5th place on the Parallel Bars. Joe was also part of the Varsity Swim Team as a diver in his Junior and Senior years, participating in a Championship Meet his Senior year. Varsity Track and Field had Joe on the Pole Vault his Junior year and he was part of the Varsity Golf Team his Senior year. In addition to his athletic achievements, Joe was involved in many other school activities. Under the mentoring of Mr. Yates, Joe enjoyed Choir, played the lead character in the school's production of Damn Yankees, took part in the dance production of American Bandstand and participated in the talent shows held over his years at Southern. ### SPHS ALUMNI CULTURAL HALL-OF-FAME 2023



Thomas J. Flynn BIOCHEMIST Class of 1965

Tom Flynn received a BS from UPenn and a Ph.D. in Biochemistry from Temple School of Medicine. After years as a Research Fellow at Temple, Tom accepted a position as a Research Chemist at the U.S. Food and Drug Administration in 1980 and remained there until his retirement in 2018. Tom's work focused on the development of novel, non-animal safety testing methods for chemicals found in food. His work was recognized and he was presented with the FDA Commendable Service Award in 1990. He was presented with many more achievement awards in 1999 and 2011 and a grant in 2008 by the FDA Office of Women's Health. In 2009, Tom was awarded a co-Principal Investigator grant for \$250,000 for his work using human liver cells and foods with potential to cause liver toxicity. Over the course of his career, Tom authored or co-authored 57 research articles, 4 book chapters, and 85 technical abstracts. Tom was an elected member of and participated actively in several professional organizations. Tom was also involved in many community outreach oriented professional activities. He mentored the "Kids and Chemistry" program, and a mentor and judge at various high school programs. In 2017, the Legacy Award "For a legacy of mentoring in areas of research and review." Tom was married for 41 years to the late Pat McGuire, he has a son David and a daughter Ellen, and he currently resides in Laurel, Maryland.



Joel Leson COLONEL U.S.ARMY (Retired) Class of 1961

Joel is a SPHS graduate class of Jan 1961. He received a BS in Political Science and Business Admin from Temple and a MS in Forensic Science from George Washington Univ. He is a graduate of the Federal Bureau of Investigation National Academy, the Federal Executive Institute, and the US Secret Service Protective Operations Course. His military schooling included a myriad of courses and training. During his 26 years of active-duty service, from 1965 to 1991, he made major contributions to the evolution of the Army Military Police Corps. His command assignments were marked by extraordinary leadership and innovation. As one of the original members of the US Army Criminal Investigation Command (CID), he went on to command CID units in the United States and Germany. Joel has received many honors and awards, including Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medals, the Army Achievement Medal and the Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry. Joel was an airborne paratrooper and a member of a helicopter crew in combat. He has been inducted into the US Army Criminal Investigation Command and US Army Military Police Corps Halls of Fame. In 2005, after 40 years of military and civilian service, Joel retired from the federal government. He became the Dir of the Center for Police Leadership at the International Assoc of Chief's of Police until he fully retired 2007.



David Jay Wolf FORENSIC SCIENTIST Class of 1972

David graduated SPHS in 1972 and attended Drexel University. He graduated in 1978 with a BS degree in Chemistry. In 1978 he was hired as an Analytical Chemist for the United States Environmental Protection Agency doing trace metal analyses of environmental water samples. From 1979 to 1981 he was employed as an Analytical Chemist for the Univ of Penn doing drug screening for the Methadone Program. From 1982 to 2014 David worked for the City of Philadelphia at the Phila Police Forensic Crime Laboratory. Starting as an Analytical Chemist, which included forensic chemistry work at the entry level, performing analysis of controlled and non-controlled substances. David became a Forensic Scientist II at the Phila Police Forensic Crime Laboratory doing instrumental analyses, going out to, and securing Clandestine drug Labs and testifying in court as an expert witness in the field of drug analyses. David continued his education in forensic science. He attended certification-training, along with seminars in Law enforcement, Forums on Designer Drugs and Clandestine Drug Laboratories. Dave has testified as a Qualified Expert Witness in the field of drug analyses for many types of drug cases for the Pennsylvania Courts of Municipal and Common Pleas, United States District Court, and Mt. Holly New Jersey Court. David also enjoys playing piano, working on automobiles, and riding in vintage WW2 Aircraft at Air Shows. He is a member of American Chemical Society, Police Department Advisory Committee and Drexel University Alumni Association. David lives in Philadelphia with his wife, Grace.
